GROUND RULES:

No alcohol permitted in the warm up area for the duration of the barrel race event

No prams or small children permitted in horse warm up area/alley way/arena entry point

No Spectators in alley way/arena entry point and are to be kept to a minimum in warm up area – there are designated spectator areas
THE ARENA WILL BE SHUT FOR 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO START TIME FOR COURSE SETTING
Payments must accompany entries
Entries must be via the ABHA website and this is encouraged to assist with the draw being advertised.

Alternatively, Notification of intent to compete must be in writing to the Secretary by the cut off date and cash payments will be accepted on the day only if pre arranged.

All entry fees are “per horse and rider combination”

All exhibitions are per run 1-minute max – If more than one pre-exhibition requested they will be taken together/same time

No Changes to horse/rider combinations will be taken on the day

Cancellations will be accepted until 6 pm on Thursday 4th of October, after this date/time entry fees will be forfeited
